¹³ Someone in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me." ¹⁴ Jesus replied, "Man, who appointed me a judge or an arbiter between you?" ¹⁵ Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions." ¹⁶ And he told them this parable: "The ground of a certain rich man produced a good crop. ¹⁷ He thought to himself, 'What shall I do? I have no place to store my crops.' ¹⁸ "Then he said, 'This is what I'll do. I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. ¹⁹ And I'll say to myself, "You have plenty of good things laid up for many years. Take life easy; eat, drink and be merry." ²⁰ "But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?' ²¹ "This is how it will be with anyone who stores up things for himself but is not rich towards God."

DBS CHECKS

Although I am no longer cluster Safeguarding officer (each parish has its own) I am still carrying out DBS checks for the whole cluster, at least for the time being. Please note that as from 1st January 2022, DBS checks must be renewed every three years instead of the previous period of five years.

I had hoped that would simply mean that when the existing ones were due for renewal, I would then renew them for three years. Sadly, the diocese has decreed that all pre existing DBS checks must be renewed after three years. So if, for example, your last DBS check was done in 2020, under the old rules it would need to be renewed in 2025. Instead it will now become renewable in 2023. More importantly, those of you whose last DBS checks were done in 2018 or 2019 will have to renew them this year.

Where I have email addresses for you, I will send out the applicant's guide. If I do not have your email, I will ask your PCC secretary or safeguarding rep for this info. If you have not given specific permission for your details to be shared they cannot do this, but the reason I am contacting you is that you have a voluntary position of some kind in the Cluster, so sharing your info is to be expected in such circumstances, particularly for safeguarding.
